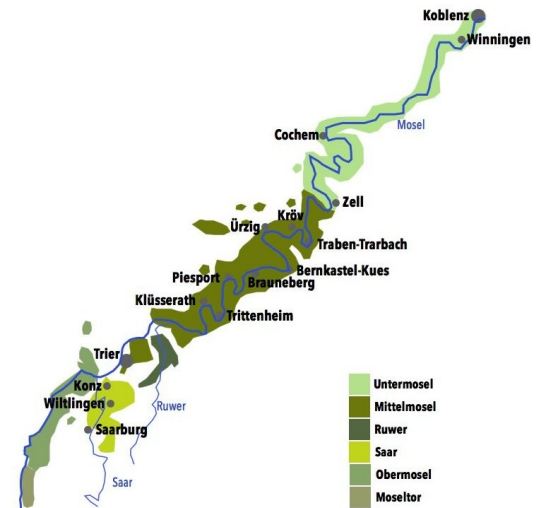

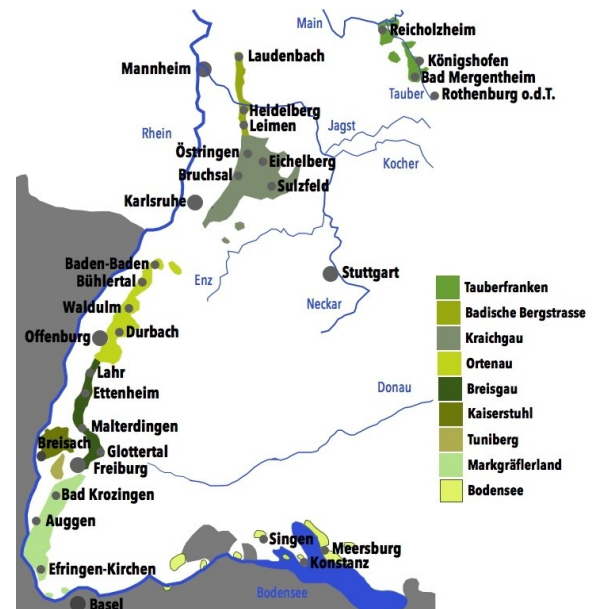

VDP.GUTSWEINE are the foundation of our origins-based philosophy and come only from our own vineyards. All wines from our winegrowers bear the VDP.Eagle on the bottleneck – as a trustworthy guarantee for the quality within.

BADEN is a small wine universe on its own – a rather warm and sunny one at that. It is bound on one side by the Lake of Constance, with its view of the Alpes, and on the other by the magnificent river stretches along the Tauber Valley. There's a section that contains the gently undulating hills of Heidelberg, and another with the Kaiserstuhl massif that rises high above the Upper Rhine River Valley. The center of the region is full of vineyards edging the Black Forest. The diversity of grape variety here is more than just a reflection of trends, but rather the natural result of real climatic and geological differences.

In the last decades, the focus is definitely developing to the varieties of the Pinot-family. With Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir all over Baden and Riesling in some of the specialized subregions.

MOSEL-SAAR-RUWER Few other German winegrowing regions enjoy such international recognition as the Mosel and its Saar and Ruwer tributaries. Its Rieslings, grown on the breathtakingly steep slopes along the gently meandering rivers, benefit from a relatively long ripening period (100 days on average, and in some years up to 130 days), which allows the aromas in the berries to ripen to perfection. The region is also one of the largest Riesling growing areas in the world. It is home not only to Germany's expensive vineyards – for example the Berncasteler DOCTOR – but also the most expensive wine of all times, a 2003 SCHARZHOFBERG Riesling Trockenbeerenauslese from VDP.Estate Egon Müller which changed hands at the VDP.Mosel auction for the fabulous price of 14.566 euros.

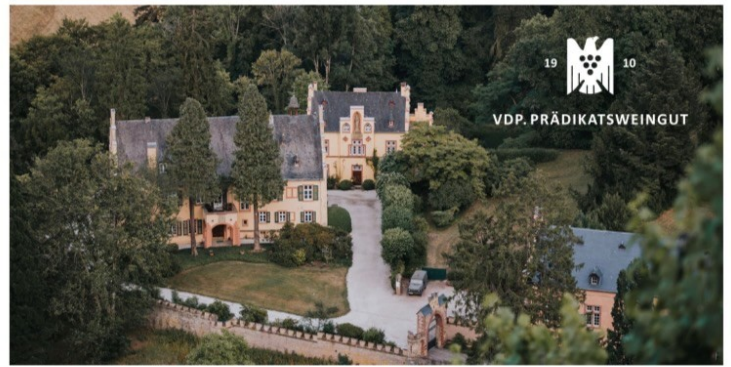

The **KARTHÄUSERHOF** is a magical place. And not primarily because of its idyllic location. It is the eighth-oldest winery in the world and for centuries the cradle of world-famous Rieslings. It was founded in 1335 by Carthusian monks, who received the country estate as a gift from Elector Baldwin of Luxembourg, and operated it as a winery until secularization. Since 1811, the estate has been in our family's possession for seven generations.



The reason for the exceptional quality of the wines from Karthäuserhof is the legendary location Karthäuserhofberg, at the foot of which the winery is situated. Its unique 'terroir' – the interplay of soil, microclimate, and other characteristics shaped both by nature and by human hands – produces wines of incomparable character and immense aging potential, which enchant wine lovers around the globe.



Wine is created in the vineyard! According to this maxim, we have been cultivating our Karthäuserhofberg for 700 years with precision and sensitivity. Each year presents individual needs, which is why we are convinced of a respectful and flexible approach to nature, in order to later produce wines of outstanding elegance.

The von Othegraven winery is one of the oldest estates in the Saar region and has been family-owned since 1805. It was a founding member of the Verband Deutscher Prädikatsweingüter (VDP).



In 2010, Günther Jauch and his wife took over the winery and are now the 7th generation to lead the estate. Günther Jauch's grandmother was born as "von Othegraven".

The wines, mainly out of Riesling vines, are prepared by the excellent cellar master Swen Klinger: manual work in the vineyards and controlled inactivity in the cellar are the key ingredients for expressing the different personality of each wine.

The vines grow in some of the most prestigious sites of the Saar valley including the amphitheater-like BOCKSTEIN in Ockfen, the historical GROSSER HERRENBURG in Wawern, and KUPP in Wiltingen, classified as VDP.GROSSE LAGE® vineyards.

Each of them contains its own unique slate soil and distinctive microclimate, coming together as grand terroir.

The monumental ALTENBERG Kanzem VDP.GROSSE LAGE®, situated directly behind the cellar, is the crown jewel of our estate. It is among the steepest sites in the world and, at 250 m in length, one of the longest of its type anywhere.

The von Othegraven wines are known and appreciated for their individual character, fresh, lively, complex with high aging potential.

The Van Volxem estate is located in the historic village of Wiltingen on the Saar, where viticulture dates back to Roman times. The estate's vineyards are situated on some of the region's most renowned steep slate slopes. It is these soils and cool climate that give our Rieslings their distinctive elegance and freshness.

Since 2000, the winery has been led by Roman Niewodniczanski, whose vision is to restore the historic reputation of Saar wines by focusing on wines that express their origin with precision and clarity.



Van Volxem is a manufactory in the classic sense, working with traditional artisanal methods in both vineyard and cellar. Sustainable farming, careful handwork and minimal intervention allow the wines to develop naturally and reflect the character of their terroir.



Our goal is to create authentic, long-lived wines of purity, elegance, and depth - wines that truly express their origin and bring lasting pleasure.

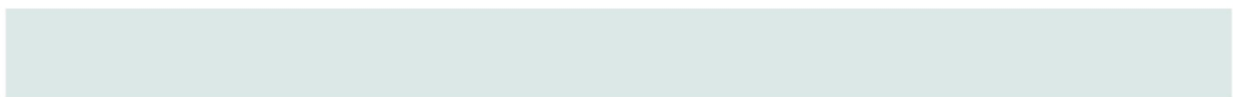

Weingüter Wegeler

Founded in 1882 by Julius Wegeler, Weingüter Wegeler stands among the historic pillars of German fine wine. For more than 140 years, the name Wegeler has been inseparably linked to the greatest Riesling terroirs of the Rheingau and Mosel — and to the conviction that truly great wine begins in exceptional vineyards. Today the estate comprises **60 hectares of vineyards**, of which **45 hectares lie in the Rheingau** and **15 hectares on the Mosel**.

From its very beginning, Wegeler followed a strategic vision that was unusual for its time. Julius Wegeler did not expand for the sake of volume. Instead, he systematically acquired only the finest classified sites in Rudesheim, Geisenheim, Oestrich, Hallgarten and beyond. This disciplined approach laid the foundation for what is today one of Germany's strongest portfolios of historic vineyard sites. The estate now cultivates **33 classified Grand and Premier Cru vineyards** and produces **12 VDP.GROSSE GEWÄCHSE**, underlining its long-standing commitment to origin-driven winemaking. The focus has never been quantity, but precision, longevity and authenticity of terroir.



The Mosel Legacy – Bernkasteler Doctor



In 1900, Julius Wegeler made a bold and historic decision by acquiring a portion of the legendary Bernkasteler Doctor vineyard at a price of 100 gold marks per vine — an extraordinary sum at the time, comparable to the annual income of a physician. This acquisition secured a permanent place for Wegeler among Germany's great vineyard owners. To this day, Bernkasteler Doctor represents depth, minerality and remarkable ageing capacity.

Wegeler's history extends beyond viticulture into political history. In September 1955, German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer travelled to Moscow to negotiate the return of the last 10,000 German prisoners of war and to establish diplomatic relations between the Federal Republic of Germany and the Soviet Union.

During a crucial diplomatic breakfast in Sosnovka, a 1953 Bernkasteler Doctor Spätlese from the Wegeler cellars was served. The 1953 vintage is widely regarded as one of the finest Riesling harvests of the 20th century, celebrated for its balance, depth and extraordinary longevity. In 2025, one of the original bottles was auctioned in Boston for approximately 20,000 USD and became known as “the wine that freed 10,000 people.” Whether symbolic or factual, the story reflects how wine can transcend the table and become part of cultural history.

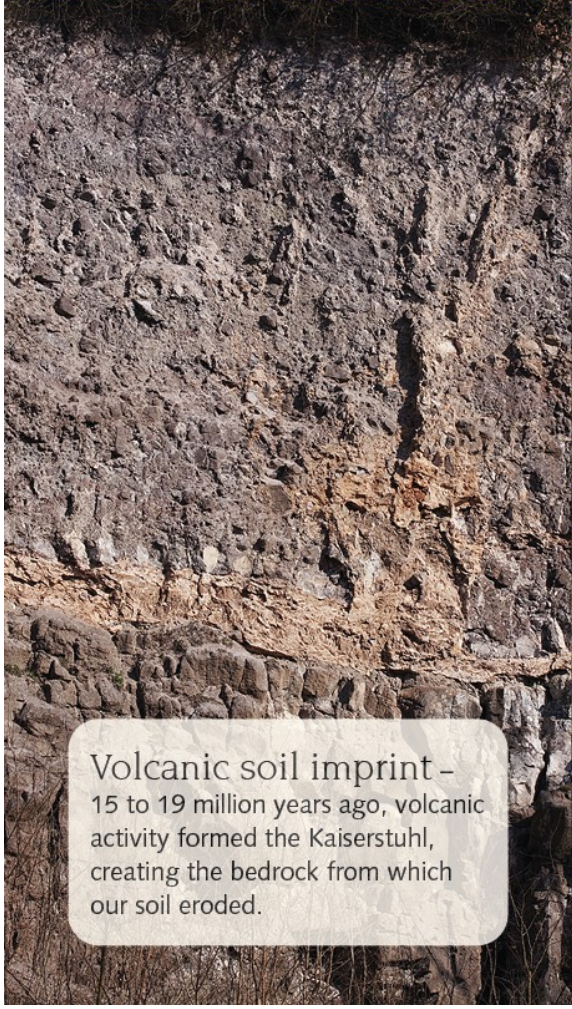

THE BEGINNING

In 2013, after my family sold our company in the Kaiserstuhl region, I chose a new path. I left behind high-end injection molding tools to dedicate myself to something just as refined — wine. Through my uncle’s small vineyard, I had developed a deep emotional connection to viticulture. I didn’t want to start small. I wanted to shape an established estate with my own vision.

When the opportunity arose to acquire Weingut Blankenhorn, I took it.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Wine is shaped by nature — guided gently by human hands. Our goal is to express terroir in its purest form. Terroir means:

- limestone-rich soils formed 170 million years ago
- the unique microclimate of the Markgräflerland
- the personality of each vineyard and vintage

We ferment mostly with natural yeasts. We allow wines the time they need. We avoid unnecessary intervention. Quality is never rushed.

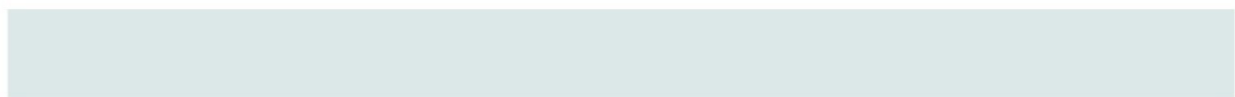

Freiherr von und zu Franckenstein

The grapes are the treasure chambers of our vines, and the greatness of our wines springs from this attitude, just as from our soils, whose mineral diversity produces exceptional wines. Our four vineyards are characterized by a mineral spectrum that is particularly rich and, in all its facets, makes the hearts of wine lovers beat faster.

We run a winery whose tradition dates back to the 13th century – this fills us with pride and at the same time obliges us, because a true winemaker does not simply produce wine. A true winemaker lives in the wine, he experiences the entire spectrum of his vineyard with every drop, the most beautiful workplace there can be. At the heart of the Ortenau lies the estate of the Freiherren von und zu Franckenstein. The oldest business record of a vineyard dates back to 1517.



The single vineyard **Laufer Gut Alsenhof** has offered excellent conditions for viticulture for centuries. Thanks to the vertical fissure structure of the gneiss weathering and sandstone soils, the vines find firm support and access to a rich nutrient supply. As deep as in the mountain, the vines are also rooted in the history of Baden winegrowing. The site was first mentioned in a document in 1493. From the Margraves of Baden, through the lords of Aubach Castle, to the Franckenstein Winery, this site has been able to delight a long line of demanding owners.

The traces of this aristocratic tradition and the ideal growth conditions in the wind-sheltered side valley are reflected in the complexity and richness of this Pinot Noir.

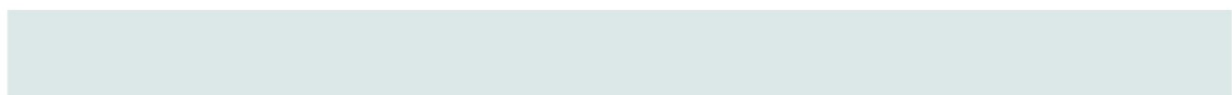

The State Winery of Freiburg

We live wine culture! The state makes wine. And pretty good wine at that. That's because we bring together passionate winemakers and passionate wine scientists. State-produced wine has been available in Freiburg for over 100 years – that's how long our state winery has been around. We emerged from, among other things, the Blankenhornsberg winery in Kaiserstuhl, which was founded in 1842. Today, we are part of the Freiburg State Viticulture Institute and thus belong to the state of Baden-Württemberg.



Quality-philosophy

A sign of our quality philosophy is our membership in the VDP since 2003. The Grape Eagle is the seal of approval for wine culture and top-quality wines that are among the best in the world. Only those who have the best vineyard sites, produce in harmony with nature, limit harvest yields and, in addition, allow the wines time to mature are permitted to bear this seal of quality. The association thoroughly checks these quality criteria every five years.

Exchange and science in practice

What does 'science in practice' mean? The state winery cultivates over 37 hectares of vineyards. Of these, 24 hectares are located on the Blankenhornsberg in Ihringen am Kaiserstuhl and 13 hectares in Freiburg and Ebringen. It is our aim to cultivate our unique vineyards sustainably in order to set an example for the wine industry. 'Practical wine science' means that we at the state winery put research findings and developments in the world of wine into practice, test new methods and cultivation techniques for Baden, and produce unique wines that cannot be found anywhere else.

'Our ECOVIN wines in particular are testament to this close cooperation,' explains Kolja Bitzenhofer, head of the state winery: 'This is because their grapes must be planted in optimal locations and cultivated according to ecological guidelines.' And that is precisely why we live our honest culture of exchange: because it is stimulating and inspiring. Because, ultimately, it produces excellent wines that our customers can enjoy. And because, together, we are advancing viticulture and bringing the future of winegrowing into the glass today!

The philosophy of the VDP.Weingut Heitlinger: pure nature!

The team therefore practises biodynamic viticulture; Heitlinger has been Demeter-certified since the 2024 vintage. Modern Pinots in all their facets are produced on 160-million-year-old limestone-sediment soils in the Kraichgau. As early as the 12th century, Cistercian monks recognised the unique conditions of the chalky hills of the Kraichgau region for Pinot grapes. Sheep graze in the Heitlinger vineyards and drones circle above the vines – this is how winemaker Patrick Jacklin interprets contemporary agriculture with the highest standards of quality.



We encourage flora and fauna to bloom and thrive in our vineyards. The magic of our wines then arises from this dynamic life, married together with the distinctive flavors of our beloved region. We in the Kraichgau are living in a Renaissance of wine culture, here where the art of viticulture was founded by the Romans and honed by Cistercian monks.

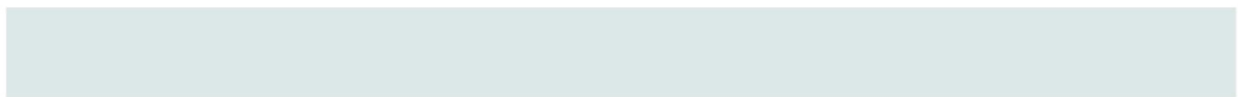

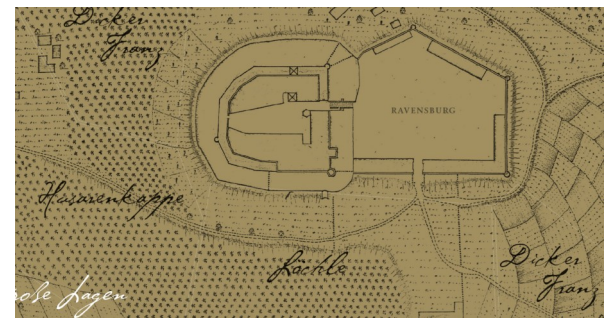
Perched high above the Kraichgau region stands the **VDP.Weingut Burg Ravensburg**. The winery was first mentioned in a document in 1251. This makes it one of the ten oldest wineries in the world and the oldest in Baden-Württemberg.

Mineral-rich soils, historic single-vineyard plots, biodynamic cultivation and the winemakers' exceptional dedication form the basis for outstanding Demeter wines here. The estate's vineyards cover a total of 35 hectares. They bear distinctive names such as 'Husarenkappe' and 'Kapellenberg' (Riesling), Dicker Franz (Blaufränkisch) and 'Löchle' (red Pinots).

The estate was entrusted to the capable hands of entrepreneur Heinz Heiler in 2009. Today, it is run by his family with great passion. Claus Burmeister is the second generation to take responsibility for viticulture. The winemaker grew up at Burg Ravensburg.



The individuality of our wines develops through natural processes, which we enrich with modern knowledge. These include hand-harvesting and careful selection of all grapes, gentle pressing and the minimal use of pumping, as well as natural fermentation.



The history of Riesling in Baden begins in 1782, when Baron von Göler von Ravensburg is said to have received Riesling vines from the Margrave of Baden. The baron brought them to Sulzfeld in a hussar's cap to plant them on the slope of his castle. That gave the site its name: HUSARENKAPPE. To this day, Rieslings of significant character are grown here.

SCHLOSS NEUWEIER

Since 2012, the winery and Schloss Neuweier have been family-owned. The historic monopoly vineyards Schlossberg and Goldenes Loch as well as Mauerberg are the heart of our estate.

Top wines with site-specific character, impressive minerality, and a variety of aromas thrive here. It is a stroke of luck that this original identity of the steep slopes has been preserved over centuries.



On our family-owned winery, we cultivate around 16 hectares of vineyard in a natural and careful manner. The most prominent vineyards stretch steeply up just behind the castle.

Warm updrafts from the Rhine Valley during the day and cool downdrafts from the Black Forest in the evening hours ensure optimal ripening and acid formation in the grapes.

In addition to these special climatic conditions, the soil structure of our vineyards is something very special. Arkose sandstone with a high content of feldspar, quartz, and mica, as well as volcanic porphyry, form the basis for distinctive, characterful wines.

Located on the outskirts of Baden-Baden, Neuweier Castle is the hub for tours in the Black Forest, the wine-growing region, or nearby Alsace. Our wine hotel offers elegant double rooms, spacious suites, as well as apartments.

We are very proud to have been a member of the VDP since 2006 and to classify our wines according to the 4-level classification system. Our best vineyards are the Laufener Altenberg, the Muggardter Berg and our VDP.GROSSE LAGE® WINGERTE, or as we call it traditionally "Klosterwingerte".

One of our main goals is to ensure that next generations can also make good wine on healthy soils. We work close to nature and use biological means.

FAMILY WINERY AT THE SOUTHERN KAISERSTUHL, BADEN

For over 140 years, the **VDP.Weingut Stigler** has stood for uncompromising quality, characterful wines, and a deep connection to the unique cultural landscape of the Kaiserstuhl and Breisgau regions. Founded in **1881**, the family winery is now run by the **fifth generation**, Maximilian and Jessica Stigler – with respect for tradition and a clear vision for the future, to produce timeless high quality wines with the Stigler-typical long aging potential.



PINOTS FROM KAISERSTUHL

On 16 hectares of vineyards, wines are produced that perfectly balance origin, craftsmanship, contemporary style and most important ageing potential. The vines are rooted in outstanding sites on the Kaiserstuhl and Breisgau, both characterized by their unique terroir: While on the **WINKLERBERG** Ihringen and **EICHBERG** Oberrotweil at Kaiserstuhl, the vines grow on weathered volcanic rock, which lends the wines power, minerality, and depth, the **SCHLOSSBERG** Freiburg – a VDP.GROSSE LAGE vineyard on gneiss – is known for its fine structure and cool elegance. These geological contrasts are reflected in the tension and complexity of Stigler wines.

We focus on cultivating regionally typical varieties such as **Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay, and Pinot Noir**. Since the winery's founding we grow **Riesling**, strongly influenced by the minerality of the volcanic soils and moreover has Andreas been the first German winegrower to plant **Chenin Blanc** in 2003 with a visionary look into the future. To add of course, our two premium sparkling wines both distinguished by their exceptionally long lees aging.

SUSTAINABILITY & TIMELESSNESS

As a founding member of the **VDP.Baden**, the Stigler family has always prioritized quality and origin in their winemaking, strived to work in harmony with nature. Sustainability is not a trend for the Stigler family, but a lived conviction. The winery is sustainably certified by **FairChoice** and has been working with their soiles end vines (e.g. cover crops, straw and drip irrigation) to promote biodiversity for decades. Herbicides are completely avoided – instead, soil health, biodiversity, and the responsible use of natural resources are at the heart of their daily work.

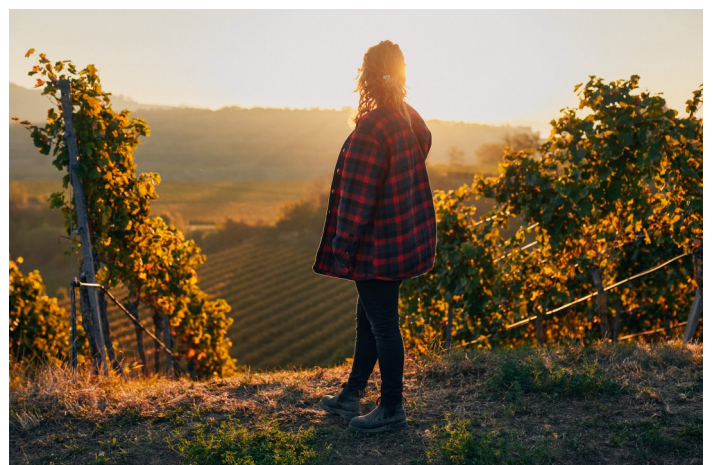
